The Beagle Club of NSW (Australia) was formed in 1962 and our main objectives are the promotion and welfare of beagles. The Club is for anyone who has a love for this wonderful breed; of course it's great if you do already own a beagle but it isn't essential. We have activities for pet owners and exhibitors alike and we look forward to welcoming you as a member.

The Club holds walks for you and your beagle/s in and around Sydney. These take in all the sights, sounds, and smells that Sydney has to offer, and range from easy rambles around dog-friendly parks to slightly more demanding walks along bush tracks. Some walks are circular, others aim for a destination and then return along the same route. Terrific fun for you and your beagle/s and a great way to get fit!

For new owners, Breed Information Days are held at least once a year with talks on training, grooming and health care. These days are held in conjunction with a Snoopy Fun Day where beagles and their owners can let the hair (or fur!) down and enjoy some fun games.

The Club is affiliated with Dogs NSW (the Royal N.S.W. Canine Council Ltd.) and conducts two Specialist Beagle shows on Easter Saturday and Sunday at Castle Hill Showground. If you would like to see lots of beagles in one place then you are more than welcome to come along.

The cost of membership is \$25 p.a. (runs from 1st July to 30th June) which covers all family members living at the same address and includes our monthly magazine, called "Harking In" which is sent to all members each month giving all the latest information on Club activities and the world of beagles.

We are also happy to help if you are having problems with your beagle whether behavioural or health related. A number of our members have been associated with beagles for many years and in most cases they will be able to offer advice. If they are unable to help, then they may be able to put you in touch with someone who can.

The Club also has a Rescue and Rehoming Scheme where we assist beagle owners to find a home for beagles that they can no longer keep. This has proven to be very successful over the past few years that it has been available. If you are looking for an older beagle then the Club may have one available that will be just right for you.
