Hi Ho, Hi Ho, it's hunting we will go... at the Annual Christmas-in-July Beagle Scent Hunt Weekend.

Saturday July 9th – Sunday July 10th 2011.



The Scent Hunt and Feast will both be held at the Bimbadeen property.

This is a Beagle only weekend.

Brialey Beagles are NOT able to house any beagles this year. Beagles staying in cabins at Bimbadeen must be crated.

Some information on some accommodation possibilities for both skin and fur people is included below.

For insurance purposes, participants **must** either be a member of The Beagle Club of NSW or sign a waiver.

EVENT DETAILS:

The weekend starts on Saturday between 11.30am – 12 Midday at Bimbadeen. Please bring your own lunch.

The afternoon consists of several drag hunts, starting with a short run to break in the new paws and to refresh the memories of some of the old paws.

Afternoon tea will be held at the main building, allowing humans and hounds to recoup their energies after the exertions of the morning. We ask that everyone bring something to share for afternoon tea. Tea and Coffee will be supplied.

This will be followed by the *Beagling the Main Drag* walk through downtown Cootamundra, after which everyone should make their way to their accommodation to prepare for the evening festivities. Around 6:00 pm we all meet at the main building for the Christmas-in-July Dinner.

Sunday 8.30 am - 9.00 am: Meet at the main house for several more scent hunts and an off-lead walk.

About 12 Noon: leave for home or, if you want to stay a little longer, you are welcome to meet again at Bimbadeen Central for tea and coffee before heading off.

We will be holding a raffle over the weekend to pay for the hire of Bimbadeen Hall, kitchen, cutlery, crockery and other equipment.

Hunt Entry this year will be **\$25 per human head**, which includes the Christmas dinner.

There will also be a **\$2 grounds fee** for each beagle participating in the Hunt to cover grounds entry costs.

RULES FOR THE HUNT

NO Runner leads at all! Leads no longer than 6' please. Dogs are too easily tangled in long leads, not to mention people!

NO Aggressive Dogs - any dog showing aggression will be asked to leave.

ALL dogs must have a fixed collar- no check chains; they are too dangerous on the hunt, as they could get hooked in a fence and choke a dog.

ALL dogs will be issued with a baggage tag bearing a contact phone number. We have never lost a dog, but better to be safe.

ACCOMMODATION

Bunkhouse accommodation is available at Bimbadeen for **\$15 per person/per night**. If you wish to reserve a place at Bimbadeen, please contact Bernadette (044 88 12 006). Dogs are welcome, but must be crated. You will need to provide your own bed linen (including pillows), blankets, towels etc.

There are also a number of dog-friendly options available around Cootamundra. If you decide to book at any these places, please **confirm** that your dog(s) may stay with you and any conditions attached (e.g. must be crated, on lead etc.). Please note, this list is by no means exhaustive – there are other options not listed here.

TIPS AND HINTS

Travel Directions: Travel time from Campbelltown to Cootamundra is about 4 hours. Drive along F2 (Hume Highway) towards Yass. Approx 5kms after you drive past the turnoff to the Yass MacDonalds, turn right into Burley Griffin Way (to Harden, Temora, Cootamundra). Drive approx 50 minutes to roundabout at Wallendbeen. Turn left and drive approx 18kms along Olympic Highway to Cootamundra. Watch out for 50km sign and 'Welcome to Cootamundra' sign. Travel approx 200m. At Sale yards, turn left into Rinkin Street. Drive to Bimbadeen. See map for final directions.

Food and Drink: Bring all food and drink for beagles. Bring morning tea and afternoon tea to share. Bring all other food, except for Saturday dinner. Shops are nearby in the town centre.

Suggestions: BYO warm clothes, good walking shoes, rain gear, hat, beanie, chairs, crate for your beagles, camera, video recorder.
