## Travelling directions

From Canberra (approximately 30 minutes from Canberra city):

- Head out to the Federal Hwy.
- Take the ramp to Sutton Road Exit, Sutton.
- Turn left onto Sutton Road, Sutton, after ramp.
- Continue along Bywong Street, Sutton.
- Turn left into Victoria Street, Sutton.
- Continue along Camp Street, Sutton.
- Turn left onto Sutton Road, Sutton.
- Continue along Cork Street, Gundaroo.
- Turn right onto Rosamel Street, Gundaroo.
- Continue along Marked Tree Road, Gundaroo.
- Arrive Lot 928 Marked Tree Road, Gundaroo.

**PLEASE ENSURE THAT YOU CLOSE THE GATE AFTER YOU WHEN YOU ENTER THE PROPERTY**

**Follow the track up past the main house until you reach the cottage and park. You can't go any further anyway.**

From NSW (approximately 1 ½ hours south of Mittagong):

- Head for Mittagong.
- Continue along the Hume Mwy entrance, Mittagong.
- Continue along Hume Hwy, New Berrima.
- Take LEFT FORK onto Federal Hwy Exit, Yarra
- Turn right onto Gunning Collector Road, Collector
- Continue along Marked Tree Road, Collector.
- Arrive Lot 928 Marked Tree Road, Gundaroo.
